# Purpose:

Parent Mentors share their unique talents to promote partnership between parents, new students, and the school community by networking and fostering collaboration through positive communication and support.





### Parent Mentor Responsibilities - Grades K-6

- 1. *Call the new families in your grade to introduce yourself* (by May 31). This responsibility will be split between the mentor moms for your particular grade. *Follow-up the phone call with an email*, including your contact info and summer connection dates. (Sample email and phone call attached.)
- 2. Attend a grade-level playdate at the Redmond campus playground (or Gym) in July and August. You are not required to be at both playdates; feel free to recruit another mom in your grade to welcome new families. ALL students will be invited to these playdates for a chance to connect with old friends and make new friends during the summer. Treats and water will be provided by the Admissions office. There will also be a representative from the Admissions office at these dates to help welcome the new families. Bef

- 3. Attend the <u>Cookies at the Creek</u> event for all K-6 families on Thursday, August 27 from 4:30 5:30 pm. Welcome in the new school year, further connect with new families and help build community within your grade. We understand that may be during your vacation time; we hope to have one mentor mom from each grade in attendance.
- 4. *Email your new families the Monday before school starts* to ensure their 'first-day-of-school' questions are answered, and invite them to sit with you at Parents and Pastries on Tuesday, September 1.
- 5. Attend the <u>Fall Tailgate and BBQ</u> on Saturday, Sept 12, 11:00 a.m.-2 p.m. Sponsored by The Grizzlies Booster Club and PTF, this fun-filled day is for the whole family! Encourage your new families to attend by emailing them that week. Ask them to meet you there at a certain time if you are going.
- 6. Call your family the last week of September and find out how they and their child are adapting to Bear Creek. We will help pass on any concerns to Division Heads or teachers. Invite the family to join you at Walka-Thon in a volunteer or cheering role!
- Check in periodically during the fall in the hallway, classroom, or through an email. Continue to help
  answer questions and make connections if needed. Your grade-level rep will also work to help all families
  feel integrated at Bear Creek.





### Parent mentor phone calls

- 1. Introduce self, how long been at BC, names/grades of kids
- 2. Did you attend an online orientation? Do you have any questions about what you learned there?
- 3. Do you know anyone at BC? How is your child feeling about changing/starting a new school?
- 4. Big summer plans? Mention playdates/Cookies at the Creek/other events
- 5. What does your child like to do? Hobbies/sports/interests
