

Map: Parking and Drop-off








Kindergarten Hallway: Door 6

Used for drop-off and for kindergarten pickup on half days:



Student Pick-Up Guidelines

<u>Traffic Flow for Cars</u>: Cars line up; pick-up location is at the West gate of playfield outside Kindergarten and Grade One hallway. While waiting, please pull as far forward as possible to alleviate congestion on 208th.

Parents are welcome to park in the parking lot and pick-up their child at assigned classrooms or under the stairs (Grade 2-Grade 4). Please see classroom pick-up rooms below.

Suggestions to facilitate the smoothest student pick-up:

- If your child needs to be secured in a car seat: please park in the parking lot and pick-up inside. Or you may pull out of the pick-up line to park and secure.


