

## Medication Administration Policy

The following summarizes The Bear Creek School's medication administration policy. The full policy may be found in the *Family Handbook* (see section 4).

- **All medication** (prescription or over-the-counter) **must be stored in the Health Room**. The *only* exceptions are: EpiPens, asthma inhalers, and insulin.
- Any student who requires a nurse or staff member to administer medication, whether prescription or over-the-counter, **must** have a health care provider signed Waiver and Authorization to Administer Medication form on file.
- Any Middle School or Upper School student who wishes to self-administer prescription medication **must** have a health care provider signed Waiver and Authorization to Administer Medication form on file and **must** store medication in the Health Room.
- Any Middle School or Upper School student who wishes to self-administer over-the-counter medication **must** have a Waiver and Authorization to Administer Medication form (parent only section) on file and **must** store medication in the Health Room.
- Generally, Lower School and Early Middle School students may **not** self-administer medication (exceptions will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis).
